MFNM recently established the **Matawa Health Co-operative (MHC)**. Its purpose is to provide collaborative and accountable health service to member First Nations. As a Cooperative, the members set the direction and it reflects the unique nature of each First Nation. The Co-op is flexible in how services are implemented, which must reflect the priorities, capacity and diversity of each First Nation.

The MHC will manage and oversee the delivery and implementation of the Indigenous Inter-Professional Primary Care Health Team. The provincially incorporated co-op consists of nine Matawa member communities – (Webequie, Neskantaga, Nibinamik, Eabametoong, Marten Falls), fly-in communities and, Aroland, Ginoogaming, Long Lake # 58 and Constance Lake First Nations are road-access.
