In April of 2018, ADLP became the Interim Managers of the Ogoki Forest through a Forestry Agreement with the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry. The Ogoki Forest Management Unit is a Crown unit approximately 10,900 km² in size and through the current Forestry Agreement, ADLP is responsible for all aspects of forest management planning, operations, silviculture and compliance. Under the direction and oversight of the ADLP board of directors, GreenForest Management Inc. (GFMI) is assisting ADLP with these responsibilities that ADLP has assumed during the interim management arrangement.
