### REVIEW OF THE MATAWA LEARNING CENTRE

**WHEREAS**, the Matawa Learning Centre was established in 2009 to provide an alternative learning centre for Matawa youth who are unable to complete their secondary education through mainstream secondary schools and other alternative programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Matawa Learning Centre Business and Strategic Plans were approved by the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly in 2013 to provide direction in the development of the Learning Centre; and

**WHEREAS**, significant changes have occurred in Matawa First Nations communities and in the federal and provincial education systems over the 4 years that the Matawa Learning Centre has been in operation; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs direct the Matawa Education Department identify and secure an external consultant to conduct a formal review of the Matawa Learning Centre and its Business and Strategic Plans, and provide recommendations for revisions to the Business and Strategic Plans; and

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs of the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly direct the Matawa Education Department to present the revised Strategic and Business Plans at the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly in July 2015.
