REDISTRIBUTION OF FIRST NATION INUIT CHILD CARE INITIATIVE TO MATAWA COMMUNITIES

WHEREAS KKETS has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa communities and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs; and

WHEREAS KKETS has been providing training and employment development services for a number of years and is now delivering and implementing a regimen of training & employment programs; and

WHEREAS KKETS has been receiving and allocating First Nation Inuit Child Care Initiative (FNICCI) funding for three of the Matawa communities; and

WHEREAS the Matawa Chiefs desire to extend the FNICCI Program to the rest of the Matawa communities as part of their employment & training model for the members of the communities who may have primary child caring responsibilities; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly hereby direct employment and social development Canada to consider and in fact redistribute First Nation Inuit Child Care Initiative to all Matawa First Nation communities; and

FURTHER BE RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly hereby direct Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment & Training Services to enter in negotiations with ESDC for the re-allocation of the FNICCI funding and report to the Chiefs at their next assembly.
