SUPPORT FOR THE RING OF FIRE ABORIGINAL TRAINING ALLIANCE TRAINING PHASE 2

WHEREAS, Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment & Training Services (hereinafter KKETS) has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa communities and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs by Resolution and in assembly; and

WHEREAS, KKETS entered into a Memorandum of Collaboration with NorOnt Resources Ltd. and Confederation College to provide, amongst other things, the provision of semi-skilled, skilled and professional skills training for Matawa communities and its members; and

WHEREAS, KKETS Services has been delivering the training programs through the Ring of Fire Aboriginal Training Alliance (hereinafter RoFATA) and has been achieving successes as Matawa community members are completing their training programs; and

WHEREAS, Employment and Social Development Canada as the funding agency is only committed to provide funding for two years ending on March 31st, 2015; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs direct KKETS to develop a Phase 2: Proposal to continue with the training programs and enter into negotiations with Employment and Social Development Canada for the continuation of the RoFATA and its training regime.
