SUPPORT FOR INCREASING STAFF POLICE OFFICERS IN FIRST NATIONS

WHEREAS, staff Police Officers are required in all of the First Nations communities within the Matawa First Nations to ensure the safety and well-being of community members; and,

WHEREAS, community-based police offices are consistently facing a lack of staff Police Officers with appropriate accommodations, endangering the safety of the communities they are in-place to serve.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 25th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly support increasing the quantity of full-time (24/7) staff Police Officers stationed in appropriate accommodations within the First Nations of the Matawa First Nations to ensure the safety of their communities; and,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Matawa First Nations Chiefs Council Staff and Management will follow-up with on-going issues, providing support for community policing and justice initiatives.
