SUPPORT FOR KIIKENOMAGA KIKENJIGEWEN EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING SERVICES 5-YEAR BUSINESS PLAN

WHEREAS, Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment & Training Services (hereinafter KKETS) has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa First Nations communities and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs by Resolution and in assembly; and

WHEREAS, KKETS has been providing training and employment development services since October 2010 and it's in its final year of the funding agreement. KKETS has developed a five-year (2015-2020) business plan complete with the strategic goals in order to support for the future needs; and

WHEREAS, KKETS has delivered a Report entitled: Successor Strategy for Aboriginal Skills and Employment Training Strategy which is an outline of the organization's plans to develop a strategic plan which will be presented to the Federal government; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly accepts the Report and further directs KKETS to use the Strategic Plan to enter into negotiations with Employment and Social Development Canada for the continuation of the ASETS and its training regime.
