REAFFIRMATION FOR KKETS AS THE ONLY HRSDC SERVICE PROVIDER FOR MATAWA MEMBER FIRST NATIONS

WHEREAS, Kiikenogama Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) was approved as the Human Resource and Skills Development Canada (HRSDC) service provider for the Matawa member First Nations; and

WHEREAS, the mandate of KKETS was supported by Chiefs Council Resolution at the 2010 Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly to offer culturally appropriate opportunities for education, training and employment by providing professional advisory support services, relevant systems and programs to empower individuals to take initiative for change in their own lives; and

WHEREAS, KKETS was supported by Chiefs Council Resolution at the 2012 Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly as the Chiefs called on HRSDC to recognize KKETS as the sole service provider and funding operator for HRSDC training and skills development programs for Matawa First Nations community members; and

WHEREAS, if HRSDC or Employment and Social Development Canada chooses to fund other service providers this will prevent KKETS from achieving their training objective and pose a threat to their mission to creating a better skilled Aboriginal workforce for all Matawa member First Nations peoples.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 25th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly reaffirm KKETS positioning as the sole service provider and funding operator for HRSDC and Employment and Social Development Canada training and skills development programs for Matawa First Nations community members.
