SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS' RESIDENCE

WHEREAS Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) is an organization dedicated to prepare, educate to train, and train for employment of Matawa First Nations members; and

WHEREAS individuals participating in KKETS education and training programs may be required to temporarily relocate to Thunder Bay while enrolled in these programs; and

WHEREAS affordable and assessable housing is limited in the City of Thunder Bay resulting in greater challenges for student transitions;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct KKETS to seek other options for student residency in the City of Thunder Bay.
