RENEWED CALL FOR NAPS POLICING OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the Matawa Chiefs supported in Resolution 08-01-08-13 increasing the staff complement of Nishnawbe-Aski Police Services (NAPS) officers in Matawa First Nations, with secure living and working facilities; and

WHEREAS, there are still a shortage of officers in First Nations which results in some communities not being covered; and

WHEREAS, Chiefs and Councils have been put in danger of having to intervene into situations where they should not be; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs Council of the 26th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly lobby Ontario and Canada to provide the resources to NAPS for a full complement of officers so communities, their councils and police officers can live in safety; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs Council of the 26th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly directs NAPS to be a component of the Regional Framework discussions.
