SUPPORT FOR THE APPLICATION FOR SPONSORSHIP FOR APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING

WHEREAS Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment & Training Services(hereinafter KKETS) has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa First Nations and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities (hereinafter MTCU) has been making changes to the apprenticeship system in the Province of Ontario designed to improve access to apprenticeship and partnerships for the management and registration of apprentices and their training; and

WHEREAS the apprenticeship system has been implemented, together with diploma and degree in education, as a fundamental component of Ontario's Education and Skills Strategy to ensure that Ontario has a highly skilled and educated work force; and

WHEREAS Ontario is expanding the apprenticeship system to include aboriginal organizations as potential apprenticeship sponsors to meet the needs of industries labour market demands and to improve access to sponsorships and registration for aboriginal apprentices;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 27th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly directs the KKETS Board of Directors to apply for apprenticeship sponsorship for Matawa trainees and apprentices to MTCU.
