### **SUPPORT FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE MATAWA REGIONAL EDUCATION STRATEGIC PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, Matawa Chiefs Resolution #2008#11 approved the adoption of the 5 year Regional Education Strategic Plan for implementation between 2008 and 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the educational landscape has changed considerably since the initial development and approval of the Matawa Regional Education Strategic Plan, and recent economic development and federal initiatives will have a significant effect on the current education system; and

**WHEREAS**, the current Matawa Regional Education Strategic Plan is now in its final year and requires renewal in 2013.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the delegates of the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly direct the Matawa Education Department, in cooperation with the Matawa Regional Advisory Committee on Education, to revise and renew the Matawa Regional Education Strategic Plan, and that this review include community consultations and input from Matawa First Nations citizens and leadership; and

**FURTHERMORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the delegates of the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly direct the Matawa Education Department to present the revised Matawa Regional Education Strategic Plan for approval at the 2014 Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly.
