SUPPORT FOR THE MATAWA FINANCIAL ADVISORY SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO SEEK FUNDING

WHEREAS the Chiefs in assembly at the 2011 Matawa First Nations Annual General Meeting accepted the Terms of Reference for the formal establishment and commencement of the Matawa First Nations Band Managers Committee; and

WHEREAS the role of the Band Manager is crucial and central to program and service delivery and administration with each member First Nation; and

WHEREAS it is recognized that each Band Manager must be informed on a wide-array of topics and issues that could affect programs, services, budgets and more; and

WHEREAS Band Managers must have an awareness of activity and decisions from all levels of governance including community, political, administrative, department and project;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs direct the Matawa Financial Advisory Services Department to secure funding to work with Band Administration and Finance Officers in preparing a needs assessment for the Matawa Communities and explore potential Professional Development opportunities.
