REQUEST FOR AANDC TO SUPPLY WATER TO MARTEN FALLS FIRST NATION

WHEREAS: Marten Falls First Nation’s water distribution facility is not up to standards and is lacking of filtering capacity which creates danger to community members due to high torpidity in the settling tank;

AND WHEREAS: Health Canada issued a water advisory in 2005 promoting Aboriginal Affairs Northern Development Canada (AANDC) to provide water supply;

AND WHEREAS: new water distribution system is under a study phase and operating a new facility is years away;

AND WHEREAS: AANDC now wants to terminate this water supply in September agreeing to supply water only for the interim until a reverse osmosis facility is installed;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Marten Falls First Nation request support to have AANDC reinstall its current supply of bottled water to everyone until the new facility is installed or when Health Canada lifts its water advisory.
