Preferred candidates will have the following assets and qualifications:

- Sensitivity and awareness of First Nations culture and traditions;
- Experience residing in northern communities and working in First Nation schools;
- Willingness to live in a small, fly-in community (approx. pop. of 1,200 and approx. 380 students);
- Willingness, along with physical ability, to work with students with diverse needs;
- A sense of adventure;
- Willingness to become involved in extracurricular activities;
- Flexibility, patience and the ability to work closely with other teaching staff, parents and principal;
- Knowledge of Ojibway.

Successful candidates will be required to provide an original, satisfactory Criminal Reference Check, including Vulnerable Sector Screening (dated within the last six months) as deemed suitable by the Employer, prior to the commencement of employment.
