For the past 24 years, Ginoogaming First Nation has been fulfilling the duty to operate pre-employment, training, and hiring processes for LLI as per the First Nation's 1993 Partnership Agreement with the Buchanan sawmill/planer facility in Longlac

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be ready, willing, and able to work a minimum of 40 hours per week (full time)
- Previous sawmill and/or planer experience are not required
- Must successfully complete an LLI job interview
- Must pass mandatory pre-employment drug testing
- Must be physically fit and able to meet the demands of various positions
- Must be able to do shift work
- Must have a highly motivated, positive attitude, and be enthusiastic about LLI work
- Must have an **operational** telephone number (this is a necessary requirement)

HOURLY RATES:

- Starting wages are contingent on work classifications and certifications, and range from \$16.30/hour-\$25.75/hour starting on December 1, 2017 (and raised every December 1 thereafter as per LLEA Collective Agreement)
- Wages may also increase by \$1.00-2.00/hr on December 1, 2017 (and raised every December 1 thereafter) due to a Market Incentive Plan as per LLEA Collective Agreement

OTHER:

- All employees are members of the <u>Long Lake Employees Association</u> (LLEA) with recent (December 2015) Collective Agreement operational to December 2020
- **Training** is available for advancement into operator, skilled trades, and other positions
- Licensed OLMA (Ontario Lumber Manufacturers Association) lumber graders are needed
- Skilled tradespeople (electricians and millwrights) are encouraged to apply
