Many people come to urgent care walk-in clinics to be treated for illnesses. These illnesses are not life-threatening. Usually they can be treated with antibiotics or other medications. Some of the most common illnesses that are treated in an urgent care facility include:

Allergies, sores, rashes, itchiness	Head lice
Pregnancy testing	Headaches
Asthma/bronchitis/pneumonia	Pink eye
Colds and flus	Sinus issues
Dehydration - diarrhea	Sexually transmitted infections/birth control
Earaches	Sore throat
Foreign bodies	Urinary Tract Infections, yeast infections
Mild stomach issues	Prescription refill (must bring old bottle)
