Vacancies: 1 Nishnawbe Aski Police Services (NAPS) Board of Director

Summary: The Matawa Chiefs Council invites any interested and qualified Matawa First Nation member to submit their name for consideration as an appointment to the NAPS Board of Directors to serve as a representative of the Matawa Tribal Council as a Director.

Qualifications / Requirements:

- Each Director shall be a natural person at least eighteen (18) years of age
- Each Director shall be a member of a First Nation which is a member of NAPS
- No Director shall be an undischarged bankrupt, or mentally incompetent
- No Director who has been convicted of a criminal offence, for which he is not eligible for a pardon, may become a member of the Board
- No Director shall be an employee of NAPS
- No Director shall be concurrently employed as a police officer or First Nations Constable

Term:

The term shall be three years subject to Matawa Tribal Council’s right to replace a Director at any time.
