Position: Physician Services Lead

Background:

Incorporated in 2017, the Matawa Health Co-operative (MHC) is a Matawa First Nations owned and controlled health co-operative that provides health care services to enhance existing health services to achieve long-term health and well-being for all members within the nine (9) Matawa First Nations. It is overseen by a Board of Directors and is a member of the Health Care Co-operatives Federation of Canada. The MHC is community-driven with available services being tailored to individual community's needs. It is the first of its kind in Canada.

The MHC works to incorporate traditional healing and medicines in addressing the wholistic health needs of the Matawa First Nations focusing on the priorities of mental health and addictions, diabetes and chronic diseases. It oversees an Inter-Professional Primary Care Health Team made up of an Executive Director, a Director of Nursing and Clinical Services, 7 Nurses (3 are Certified Diabetes Educators), 1.5 Physicians (part-time), 1 Foot Care Nurse, 1 Dietician, 1 Nurse Practitioner, and 2 Mental Health Counsellors providing direct services in the Matawa First Nations or through telemedicine.

The organization is accepting applications for a Physician Service Lead.

Position Summary:

The Physician Service Lead will deliver primary health care services to all Matawa communities and provide strong leadership and management for MHC Physicians. Specific duties include:

- Provide daily leadership to physicians, ensuring physicians are performing duties in a manner supportive of the organizational goals and MHC Strategic Vision via team development activities, coaching and performance management
- Deliver comprehensive primary health care services to patients of the MHC
- Develop medical policies/administrative procedures for the organization
- Foster effective collaboration between health staff, internal and external stakeholders
- Conduct quarterly performance reviews with physicians
- Work with other health care providers of the Matawa communities

Preferred Qualifications, Experience, Knowledge and Abilities:

The Physician Services Lead must:

- Have an advanced medical degree and have experience in health management
- Minimum 2 years management/supervisory experience
- Demonstrated understanding and a commitment to an integrated and team base model
- Ability to work efficiently, both independently and as a part of a multi-disciplinary team
- The successful candidate will hold a Medical Doctor (MD) degree and be in good standing with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario
- The candidate will hold a Certification in the College of Family Physicians license in Canada

The incumbent should also have proficient knowledge in the following areas:

- Exceptional oral, written and presentation skills
- Excellent interpersonal communication and, organizational skills
- Capacity to adapt quickly to a fast-paced, dynamic work environment
- Knowledge of various computer systems and applications (i.e. Microsoft Office, PS) Suites, etc.)
