What is the Victim Services Program?

Victim Services provides culturally relevant services to victims of crime within the Matawa First Nation Communities. Our main goal is to increase community awareness about the program, victimization and increase access to services, safety and security.

Types of support:

- immediate crisis intervention
- · basic counselling and referral
- assessment
- safety & treatment/healing planning
- case management
- active membership in crisis/emergency teams
- accompaniment to police services
- assistance in applying for resources
- community awareness & education

Victim Services can also provide:

- community engagement activities
- organize, coordinate and facilitate community information sessions to include community-based and external service providers
- build partnerships with other service providers and agencies
- integrated, cohesive and safe service to victims of:
 - domestic violence
 - sexual assault
 - serious physical assault
 - homicide/attempted murder
 - break & enter
 - criminal harassment
 - elder abuse
 - human trafficking
 - other crime-related occurences
