What is VQRP?

The Victim Quick Response Program (VWRP) offers timely assistance to victims of violent crime.

The program contributes financial assistance to victims of:

- domestic violence
- sexual assault
- serious physical assault
- homicide
- attempted murder
- hate crimes
- human trafficking



Who can apply:

- the victim
- immediate family member
- custodial guardian of a minor child
- individual with legal authority to act on behalf of a victim with special needs

Are you eligible?

VQRP offers immediate assistance to victims of crimes when services and funding are not available through other sources.

To be eligible:

- victim must reside in Ontario
- the crime must have occurred in Ontario
- the crime must be reported to the police
- in the event of domestic violence, hate crime or sexual assault the crime can be reported to service agencies dealing with those types of crimes (domestic violence shelter, hospital, etc.)
- applications for emergency and funeral expenses must be received no later than 45 days after the date of the crime
- applications for counselling must be received no later than 90 days after the date of the crime
