Job Summary:

This is a camp-based position in the Ogoki Forest. Camp accommodation is provided as well as a “living-out” allowance.

Wage: depending on experience

Responsibilities:

Safe and efficient operation of Agoke Development LP (ADLP) grader.

Complete daily pre-trip and walk-around safety inspections, as well as check all fluid levels and grease when necessary. Maintain heavy equipment in good operating condition, reporting and logging maintenance requirements or concerns.

Follow the daily plan/requirements as instructed by the Road Supervisor or supervisor designate.

Complete documentation as required.

Communicate effectively and professionally with other team members and forestry road travelers.

Comply with all company, Northern Development Mines & Natural Resources & Forestry (NDMNR), and legislated safety policies and procedures.

Qualifications:

Prefer three years of experience grading forestry type roadways.

Must have and maintain a valid driver's license as well as own reliable transportation (a pick-up truck). There may be the option of using ADLP's truck. A fuel/vehicle allowance is paid per kilometer.

Work Conditions:

Must be open to variable shift work, especially during inclement weather.

Work will be outdoors in various weather conditions.
