- #16-28-07-22 Matawa Chiefs Council Reject Processes that are Proceeding without the Consent of Indigenous Rights Holders
- #17-28-07-22 Matawa Member First Nations Reject Metis Assertions in the Matawa Homelands and Territories
- #20-28-07-22 Matawa Chiefs Council Accepts Revised Draft Mining Resolution for Further Review, Input and Consideration
