plan, develop, organize, and provide educational and cultural workshops within the Choose Life program to the reach to children and youth

- Three years' experience in program development and implementation with a strong sense of Indigenous culture and mental health priorities for Indigenous Youth.
- Demonstrated knowledge of approaches to integrating mental health supports and land-based programs.
- Awareness of a trauma informed approach in program implementation or a willingness to be trained.
- Demonstrated understanding of and commitment to sharing traditional teachings, approaches, and principles.
- An ability to speak the Marten Falls language is an asset.
