Position: Approaches to Community Wellbeing (ACW) Facilitator

Summary:

The approaches to Community Wellbeing Facilitator provides expertise and support services to four Matawa First Nations; Eabametoong, Neskantaga, Nibinamik and Webequie, and two partially serviced First Nations; Aroland and Marten Falls, to facilitate and coordinate the establishment, development, planning, implementation and monitoring of the community-based activities related to ACW. The position works in collaboration with the community-based Health Directors/Managers and the Health Team. ACW Facilitator will travel to the communities to assist in developing and determining appropriate management and delivery structures, identify and prioritize program, and coordinate communication, education awareness and promotional activities as required. ACW Facilitator will liaise with other regional ACW Facilitators, Tribal Councils and will have a close working relationship with SLFNHA and other service providers. ACW Facilitator will work under the direction and supervision of Matawa Health and Social Meno Biimadeswin Director.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Certificate/Diploma in a health-related field
- Minimum Grade 12 and previous experience working in health
- Must be “fully vaccinated” against COVID-19
- Possess a valid Ontario driver’s license;
- Must submit a current Criminal Record Check;
- Fluency in Cree or Ojibway is a definite asset.
- Must be able to travel extensively
