SUPPORT FOR KKETS' STUDENTS TO RECEIVE FULL ONTARIO WORKS EXEMPTION WHILE PARTICIPATING IN THE ABORIGINAL SKILLS ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) is an organization dedicated to prepare, educate, train and employ Matawa First Nation members; and

WHEREAS KKETS' students who are in receipt of Ontario Works financial supports are fully exempt from any deductions by the Ministry of Community and Social Services while enrolled in the Aboriginal Skills Advancement Program (ASAP); and

WHEREAS the participation in the Aboriginal Skills Advancement Program includes the grade 12 academic Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements, post-secondary entrance academic requirements, life skills, social and cultural programming, employment readiness and basic industrial certifications

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct the Ministry of Community and Social Services to continue with the full exemptions with consideration to all ASAP programming components for all KKETS' participants in receipt of Ontario Works while enrolled in the Aboriginal Skills Advancement Program.
