SUPPORT FOR NEW EABAMETOONG FIRST NATION POLICE STATION

WHEREAS, Eabametoong First Nation is the largest First Nation member of Matawa and has distinct needs in the areas of policing; and

WHEREAS, there are additional requirements of office space, accommodations and cell space that do not fit into the standard Nishnawbe-Aski Policing (NAPS) Offices; and

WHEREAS, a temporary trailer has been supplied by Eabametoong First Nation for their NAPs officers and prisoners for a period of two years, which does not meet the policing, public safety and labour standard needs of the First Nation, the officers, or prisoners.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 25th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly support permanent policing capital facilities in Eabametoong First Nation which would include office space, accommodations, cells and other structures that meet safety, labour and community standards.
