## **RESOLUTION #09-28-07-16**

## **RENEWAL OF ASETS PROGRAM**

WHEREAS KKETS has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa communities and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs; and

WHEREAS KKETS has been providing training and employment development services for a number of years and is now delivering and implementing a regimen of training programs including employment and integration services; and

WHEREAS Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC) has renewed its employment & training program and is now considering entering a new agreement and developing a new allocation model; and

WHEREAS the Assembly of First Nations has been appointed by Chiefs Resolution to study and develop a new funding allocation model that will inform ESDC on how to allocate employment & training funding to ASETA holders;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Matawa Chiefs in Assembly recommend the following as factors to be included in the allocation model:

- a) **Isolation**: this should be considered due to the high cost of living and geographical locations of the indigenous communities north of 50<sup>th</sup> parallel;
- b) **High unemployment rate**: the rate of unemployment in the northern communities needs to be a factor in the allocation model which is never considered in labour market studies for the northern communities;
- c) Language: should be considered in the northern indigenous communities because English is not our first language, consideration needs to be made language translation;
- d) **Service delivery component**: for organizations that deliver services to the northern Indigenous communities, a northern factor needs to be added in the calculation for administration and not limiting it to fifteen (15) percent.
