### SUPPORT FOR RENEWAL FUNDING OF THE ABORIGINAL SKILLS ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (hereinafter KKETS) is an organization dedicated to prepare and educate Matawa First Nations members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aboriginal Skills Advancement Program (hereinafter ASAP) will ensure Matawa First Nations members are ready to pursue specialized training, post-secondary education and/or employment opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, ASAP will address education barriers to further post-secondary, training and employment through the achievement of an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD); and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs Council of the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly support and direct KKETS to pursue Core Funding to continue the delivery and implementation of ASAP in collaboration with Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities (MTCU) and Ministry of Community Social Services (MCSS) and under terms and conditions to be established through negotiations.
