PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN KKETS AND FIRST NATIONS ONTARIO WORKS PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) is an organization dedicated to prepare, educate to train, and train for employment of Matawa First Nations members; and

WHEREAS, the Aboriginal Skills Advancement Program (ASAP) within KKETS will assist Matawa First Nations members in preparing and pursuing specialized training, post-secondary education and/or employment opportunities; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for collaboration between the Matawa First Nations Ontario Works Departments at the community level and KKETS of Matawa;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct Matawa First Nations' Ontario Works Administrators to refer community clients to the Aboriginal Skills Advancements Programs as the first point of intervention.
