REAFFIRMATION OF SUPPORT FOR MATAWA SKILLED WORKERS ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS Mamow Kush Kii Ho Win - Matawa Skilled Workers Association (the “Workers Association”) was incorporated by Letters Patent on October 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS the Workers Association is an association owned by the Matawa communities; and

WHEREAS the mandate of the Workers Association is to help Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment & Training Services (“KKETS”) graduate workers from the Matawa communities find and obtain employment in their skilled trades, to provide support to those workers, and to be a source of information and support for workers; and

WHEREAS the Workers Association will work with prospective employers to source and match workers with jobs; and

WHEREAS the Workers Association is intended to work alongside with and in conjunction with KKETS; and

WHEREAS the Matawa Chiefs wish to provide continued support to the Workers Association further its mandate; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Members of KKETS by their respective Chiefs in Assembly, hereby commit to continue to support the mandate of the Workers Association and thereby provide their support to all of the KKETS graduates and other Matawa community members to become a member of the Workers Association; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that KKETS shall be directed to subsidize the membership fees in the Workers Association for those graduates and other Matawa community members wishing to join the Workers Association.
