SUPPORT FOR GUARDIANS PROGRAM RESEARCH

WHEREAS Four Rivers, Matawa's Environmental Services Group, was informally tasked at the December 2015 Chiefs Meeting with gathering information to develop potential Long-Term Regional Environmental Monitoring Network models (AKA Guardians Programs) for Leadership to consider; and

WHEREAS the foundation of Four Rivers' program funding changed April 1, 2016, and is no longer able to support this research and host the associated discussions surrounding Community-Based Monitoring and possible Guardians Network Programming; and

WHEREAS the need for information gathering and discussions to be conducted by Four Rivers surrounding Long-Term Regional Environmental Monitoring Network models is still present and supported by the Matawa member First Nation Chiefs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly support Four Rivers in the submission of proposals to secure funding to support this needed research and the associated discussions; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly formally task Four Rivers with gathering information to develop potential Long-Term Regional Environmental Monitoring Network models (AKA Guardians Programs) for discussion and consideration by the Matawa member First Nation communities.
