SUPPORT FOR KKETS TRAINING PROCESSES COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (hereinafter KKETS) has the mandate to deliver employment and training related services to Matawa First Nations communities and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs by Resolution and in assembly; and

WHEREAS, KKETS has been providing employment and training development services for a number of years and is now delivering and implementing a series of training programs; and

WHEREAS, KKETS has been involved in promoting, recruiting and assessing potential trainees and managing participants as they enter and partake in the series of training programs and KKETS wants to form a committee to better support the participants who are in training; and

WHEREAS, KKETS has gained experience and learned practices regarding the development and implementation of training programs of this nature and now wants to establish a KKETS – Training Processes Committee to examine and develop good practices; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs Council of the 26th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly approve the development of a KKETS Training Processes Committee to utilize First Nation involvement and that this committee shall make regular reports to the KKETS Board of Directors and the Matawa Chiefs Council.
