SUPPORT FOR RECREATION PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING THE MATAWA LEARNING CENTRE

WHEREAS the Matawa Learning Centre provides academic and recreation programming for students from Matawa First Nation communities; and

WHEREAS the recommendations of the First Nations Youth Inquest include addressing the recreational needs of students at the Matawa Learning Centre; and

WHEREAS the Matawa Learning Centre has submitted a Community, Youth & Cultural Funding Program Operating & Sustaining Grant Application to the City of Thunder Bay to support recreation activities for Matawa students;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly support the application to the City of Thunder Bay for an operating grant to support recreation activities for Matawa students; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct the Matawa Learning Centre to explore additional opportunities for recreational programming for Matawa students in Thunder Bay.
