RESOLUTION of the Matawa Chiefs passed at the 28th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly in Eabametoong First Nation to be effective from and after 1:00pm Eastern Standard time on July 28, 2016

RESOLUTION #17-28-07-16

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE FIRST NATIONS YOUTH INQUEST

WHEREAS the jury's recommendations from the First Nation Youth Inquest (FNYI) have been presented, and Matawa Learning Centre (MLC) and Matawa First Nations Management (MFNM) have been directed to provide activities to better support to students attending school both on- and off-reserve; and

WHEREAS MFNM and other parties indicated during the FNYI that additional resources are required to carry out any recommendations coming out of the inquest; and

WHEREAS MFNM and MLC have a legal obligation to report on the implementation of recommendations of FNYI on June 28, 2017.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly fully support the recommendations of the FNYI; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct MFNM and MLC to work with identified First Nation organizations and governments to implement the recommendations of the FNYI conditional upon the availability of human and financial resources; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct the Government of Canada to uphold its fiduciary responsibility and provide sufficient resources to MFNM and MLC to implement the FNYI recommendations; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct MFNM and the Matawa Education Department provide regular updates on the implementation of the FNYI recommendations to the Matawa Chiefs.
