SUPPORT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MINING ESSENTIALS PRE-TRADES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) is the primary organization dedicated to creating a better skilled Aboriginal workforce for all Matawa member First Nations; and

WHEREAS, KKETS has recognized a need to develop a Mining Essentials program that will enhance relationships and co-operation among First Nations communities, educators and industry by supporting training and hiring goals; and

WHEREAS, the Mining Essentials program is a unique work readiness program for First Nations peoples in mining. The program aims to ensure Matawa member First Nations peoples have the essential skills and work-readiness training needed to enter mining and to provide industry with a local, employment-prepared workforce; and

WHEREAS, the Mining Essentials program would empower Matawa member First Nations individuals to change their lives and bring this confidence and inspiration back to their community.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 25th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly direct KKETS to develop a Mining Essential Pre-Trades program for up to 45 Matawa member First Nations youth and work collaboratively with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities (MTCU);

AND BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the delegates of the 25th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly direct MTCU to provide KKETS with the financial resources needed to develop and implement the Mining Essential Pre-Trades program for up to 45 Matawa member First Nations youth.
