### **APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEFS' SPOKESPERSON FOR MATAWA EDUCATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Matawa Chiefs' *Resolution 2009/#10* approved the appointment of a Chiefs' Spokesperson for Matawa Education, and

**WHEREAS**, the mandate for the Matawa Chiefs' Spokesperson for Matawa Education is for two years or until the appointed spokesperson is no longer able to fulfill this responsibility, and the current Matawa Chiefs' Spokesperson for Matawa Education is no longer able to fulfill this responsibility.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the delegates of the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly appoint Chief Johnny Yellowhead as their Spokesperson for Education for two years or until the appointed spokesperson is no longer able to fulfill this responsibility; and

**FURTHERMORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the delegates of the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly direct the Matawa Education Department to provide an update to the Spokesperson for Education as early as possible on the immediate issues related to education policies, programming and funding, and current strategies that target these issues.
