MEDICAL TRANSITION HOUSING STUDY IN THUNDER BAY

WHEREAS, the Matawa Chiefs have consistently recognized the need for medical transitional housing in Thunder Bay for community member who have to relocate for a variety of medical reasons; and

WHEREAS, there are on-going issues of translation, transportation and the high costs of rental housing in Thunder Bay; and

WHEREAS, there are specialized needs for short, medium and long-term housing and care for individuals requiring medical treatments in Thunder Bay; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs Council of the 26th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly direct and monitor a feasibility study into a Medical Transitional Housing Program in Thunder Bay; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the study look at the variety of needs and supportive housing required for medical patients, and their families, in Thunder Bay; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this study be reported back to the Matawa Chiefs Council on a regular basis.
