### HEALTH DIRECTOR TRAVEL, SUPPORT AND CAPACITY BUILDING

**WHEREAS** a State of Emergency has been declared in Nishnawbe-Aski Nation, including Matawa First Nations Communities, on the various health and social crisis; and

**WHEREAS** Matawa First Nations has been selected by Health Canada to establish a Health Co-operative Initiative to support improved health and social services in First Nations and community control; and

**WHEREAS** funding has not been provided for First Nation Health Directors travel for community, administrative support and capacity building, including travel to Matawa Annual General Meetings; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct the Matawa First Nations Management to seek additional funding for First Nation Health Directors travel for community, administrative support and capacity building, including travel to Matawa Annual General Meetings; and

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED** Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct Indigenous and Northern Development Canada, Ministry Health and Long Term Care, Ministry of Community and Social Services, Ministry of Youth and Children's Services, and others to support this request through funding arrangements for the Health Directors.
