SUPPORT FOR MATAWA NISHNAWBE WORKERS ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewin Employment and Training Services (KKETS) has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa First Nations and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs; and

WHEREAS KKETS has trained and certified 314 Matawa members through the RoFATA Training Project with their Industrial/Trades Certifications and Level- 1 Apprenticeship Training and who are now poised for their apprenticeship placements and are employment ready; and

WHEREAS it has become increasingly clear that the Matawa members whom have been trained and certified continue to experience apprenticeship and employment barriers due to a number of factors related to the labour market demands and systems;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 27th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly directs the KKETS Board of Directors to develop a Matawa Nishnawbe Workers Association that will organize our workers into a favourable position to compete for jobs and employment.
