IMPROVING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MATAWA ECCs AND ONTARIO WORKS ADMINISTRATORS

WHEREAS, many Matawa First Nations members are impacted when participating in KKETS training programs where they are disqualified from Ontario Works’ benefits, income supports and housing; and

WHEREAS, KKETS advocates on behalf of the trainees and learners to ensure there is no disruption of Ontario Works’ benefits during their participation by working collaboratively with Ministry of Community and Social Services - Ontario Works (MCSS – OW) program; and

WHEREAS, it is crucial to improve the relationships between the Matawa member First Nations Employment Community Counsellors (ECCs) and the Ontario Works Administrators (OWAs) that will result in better services and supports for Matawa First Nations members; and

WHEREAS, KKETS is seeking resolution to be appointed as the organization to work with the MCSS - OW Program and be the bridge to improve the working relationships by nurture partnerships between the ECCs and OWAs;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 25th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly appoint KKETS as the organization to work with MCSS- OW Program and be the bridge to improve relationships with ECCs and OWAs.
