SUPPORT FOR CONTINUATION FOR THE ROFATA TRAINING PROJECT AS PER SPF ANNOUNCEMENT IN APRIL 2015

WHEREAS Kilkenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment & Training Services(hereinafter KKETS) has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa First Nations and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs; and

WHEREAS On April 10th 2015 The Minister of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada announced on behalf of the right honorable Stephen Harper Prime Minister of Canada the extension of the Skills and Partnership Fund in the amount of 50 Million a year commencing in April 1st 2016; and

WHEREAS the SPF funding is earmarked for the improvement of skills, training and access to job opportunities for the aboriginal population in response to the changing needs and requirements of the Canadian labour market; and

WHEREAS the SPF announcement indicates that access for funding is a competitive process that requires as a condition of acquiring funds the establishment of partnerships with industries and the submission of a comprehensive proposal;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates of the 27th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly directs the KKETS Board of Directors to develop and submit a proposal to ESDC for Phase: 2 of the RoFATA Training Project for consideration of SPF funding.
