## **CHIEFS SUB-COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Province has initiated a plan for DEVCO with a timeline of 60 days after election; and

WHEREAS, the Matawa Chiefs would like to work in a co-operative manner with all developments in their collective territory and have signed the Unity Declaration; and

WHEREAS, the Matawa Chiefs recognize a need to develop a Regional Structure to complement community initiatives; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a Chiefs sub-committee to investigate individual First Nation concepts that could formulate a Regional Infrastructure Plan; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs Council of the 26th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly support the creation of a Chiefs Sub-Committee to investigate issues and then present material back to the Chiefs for Review; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Chiefs Sub-Committee is only to investigate issues and not negotiate.
