## SUPPORT FOR THE MATAWA FINANCIAL ADVISORY SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO SEEK FUNDING

**WHEREAS** the role of the Band Manager is crucial and central to program and service delivery and administration with each member First Nation; and

**WHEREAS** it is recognized that each Band Manager must be informed on a wide-array of topics and issues that could affect programs, services, budgets and more; and

**WHEREAS** Band Managers must have an awareness of activity and decisions from all levels of governance including community, political, administrative, department and project;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs direct the Matawa Financial Advisory Services Department to secure funding to work with Band Administration and Finance Officers in preparing a needs assessment for the Matawa Communities and explore potential Professional Development opportunities.
