### SUPPORT FOR KIIKENOMAGA KIKENJIGEWEN EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING SERVICES COMMUNITY FACILITATION MODEL (PREPARATION PROGRAM)

**WHEREAS** Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) has the mandate to deliver training and employment related services to Matawa First Nations and its members as established by the Matawa Chiefs; and

**WHEREAS** there are some Matawa members that do not have access to employment and job opportunities due to their lack of skills, training and education and are experiencing social challenges and behaviours that contribute to their incapacity and prevents them from taking advantage to any skill development, training and education; and

**WHEREAS** there is a recognizable need to develop a Community Facilitation Model (Preparation Program) that is community-based and will assist Matawa members with social stabilization; exposes them to career planning and transitions them into training for employment;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the delegates of the 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly directs the KKETS Board of Directors to develop a Community Facilitation Model (Preparation Program) for a proposal submission to Federal and Provincial Governments, and the progress be reported to Chiefs Council on a regular basis.
