SUPRORT SERVICES FOR MATAWA MEMBERS IN THUNDER BAY

WHEREAS: There are a number of First Nation members, especially Elders, who have to re-locate to Thunder Bay for medical purposes;

AND WHEREAS: There is limited or no services for First Nation members who have to relocate to Thunder Bay, especially in the areas translation, housing, transition and financial support;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED The Matawa First Nations Chiefs in Assembly direct Matawa Health and Social Services Task Group and Matawa First Nations Management to seek funding from Ontario and Canada and actively work towards providing support services in Thunder Bay;

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Matawa First Nations Chiefs in Assembly direct the Matawa Health and Social Services Task Group and Matawa First Nations Management to continue its effort to establish a transitional housing program for Matawa First Nation members who must relocate to Thunder Bay.
