WHEREAS KKETS students/trainees participating in its programs temporarily reside at the Confederation College dorm residency that fails to provide a positive and safe environment, and;

WHEREAS there is a current shortage of temporary housing available in the City of Thunder Bay, so;

THEREFORE, BEIT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly support KKETS in securing its own residence for its students and trainees in Thunder Bay.

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that a report on progress of a KKETS students/trainees residence be provided to the Matawa Chiefs on an ongoing basis.
