RESOLUTION of the Matawa Chiefs passed at the 30th Annual Matawa Chiefs Assembly in Nibinamik First Nation to be effective from and after 1:00pm Eastern Standard time on August 2, 2018

APPROVAL OF KIKENOMAGA KIKENJIGEWEN EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING SERVICES (KKETS) INDIGENOUS SKILLS AND EMPLOYMENT STRATEGY 10-YEAR FUNDING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS Matawa First Nations Management (MFNM) provides employment and training programs through KKETS, and;

WHEREAS KKETS is currently implementing a community-based Aboriginal Skills Employment and Training Strategy, now known as an Indigenous Skills Employment and Training Strategy, and is an Indigenous Skills Employment and Training Agreement (ISETA) Holder, and;

WHEREAS KKETS is currently in the third year of extension as an ISETA Holder with Canada through the Employment & Social Development Canada (ESDC), and;

WHEREAS ESDC has announced that all ISETA holders are now in the first-year of a new 10-year Indigenous Skills Employment and Training Strategy and negotiation of a new ISETA is to begin immediately, so;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly approve and endorse the KKETS negotiation developments for a new 10-year ISETA with ESDC, and;

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly direct KKETS to work towards finalizing a 10-year ISETA with ESDC, and;

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that KKETS provide annual reports to the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly on the negotiation and implementation of the new 10-year ISETA with ESDC.
