### RESOLUTION #27-02-08-18

#### IMPLEMENTATION OF MANDATE TO CREATE MATAWA YOUTH, WOMENS AND ELDERS COUNCILS

**WHEREAS** some Youth, Women and/or Elders Councils currently exist in the Matawa First Nations, and;

**WHEREAS** Youth, Women and Elders in Matawa need a voice and, a sustainable, formalized mechanism to come together to share ideas and to develop and implement plans moving forward, and;

**WHEREAS** the Matawa Chiefs passed Resolutions #25-08-02-12, #26-08-02-12, #27-08-02-12 during the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting (AGM) held in Webequie First Nation from July 31, August 1 and 2, 2012 providing the mandate for Matawa First Nations Management to assist in creating Youth, Women and Elders Councils within Matawa, and;

**WHEREAS** since the 24<sup>th</sup> Matawa AGM, for a number of reasons, these Resolutions have not been able to be implemented to any large extent, although some efforts have been made, so;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Matawa Chiefs in Assembly mandate Matawa First Nations Management to fulfill the mandates provided in previous Resolutions indicated above to create Matawa Youth, Women and Elder Councils through assigning personnel, workplans, proposals and resources, and;

**FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED** that ongoing reports on progress be provided at Matawa Chiefs Council meetings throughout the year with a goal for implementation Matawa Youth, Women and Elders Councils by the Matawa 31<sup>st</sup> AGM in 2019.
