DIRECTION FOR KIIKENOMAGA KIKENJIGEWEN EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING SERVICES (KKETS) TO REGISTER AS A PRIVATE SCHOOL

WHEREAS Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) is an organization dedicated to prepare to educate, educate to train, train for employment and accreditation of Matawa First Nation members; and

WHEREAS KKETS invests time and money into each individual who participates in its education, training and employment programs; and

WHEREAS there is a need for KKETS to be registered as a private school to better capitalize on current and future funding for its programs, services, training and accreditation.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs Council direct KKETS to be registered as a Private School for the practices of education, apprenticeships, training, employment and accreditation; and

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED that the Matawa Chiefs Council fully support KKETS to form a Private School to allow for KKETS and Matawa to grant accredited and certified education, apprenticeships, training and employment programs.
